

Speaker Biography – Stefan Lethagen



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Stefan Lethagen is Vice President, Medical and Clinical Sciences, at Swedish Orphan Biovitrum, Stockholm, Sweden. Academic degrees include Professor in Haemophilia and other Coagulation Disorders at Copenhagen University, Denmark, and Associate Professor (Docent) in Internal Medicine at Lund University, Sweden.

Before joining Sobi in 2013, Stefan Lethagen was International Medical Director at Novo Nordisk, Denmark for about four years. Stefan Lethagen has almost 25 years' clinical experience within Thrombosis and Haemostasis and as a haemophilia treater both as Director of the Copenhagen Thrombosis and Haemostasis Centre at Copenhagen University Hospital, Denmark, and Senior Consultant at the Department for Coagulation Disorders at Malmö University Hospital, Sweden. He was one of the founders and chairman of the Nordic Haemophilia Council and Medical Advisor of FBIS, the Swedish NMO of the World Federation of Haemophilia (WFH), and medical advisor to several pharmaceutical companies.

Stefan Lethagen has published more than 130 scientific articles in peer-reviewed international journals, and several books and book chapters.

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
